Give Cheerfully

2 Corinthians 9:7 ESV

Ways to Give

1. One-off bank transfer

This is where you make a one off gift to the church direct from your bank account. The best way to do this is through your bank, online or through your local branch. Our bank details are overleaf.

2. Regular Bank Transfer or Standing Order

This is where you make regular monthly payments to the church direct from your bank. Regular giving this way is a great way of making sure they give in a disciplined, organised way. 3. Giving cash or cheques

You can give by cash or cheques (payable to 'Bethel Evangelical Church Otley'). You can put these gifts into the grey box on the welcome desk at church or post them to our church office (address overleaf).

Gift Aid
